



Get Artistic grants are intended to support the livelihood of artists and arts-focused nonprofit organizations alike. This includes art in its many forms—e.g., visual art, performance, music, writing, film, and so on. To qualify for *Get Artistic* funding, an artist, producer, or agency must: (1) Meet all RFP requirements, and (2) Grant Creature Comforts Brewing Co. use of any work produced by *Get Artistic* funding, which would include any profit-generating usage (e.g., can or label art). All *Get Artistic* grant funds will be disbursed at the end of 2019 to fund 2020 projects.

NONPROFITS

Registered nonprofit organizations supporting the arts in the Athens area are eligible to apply for 2019 grant funding. Applications are due **September 1, 2019**.

ARTISTS

Independent artists in the Athens area may apply for 2019 *Get Artistic* grant funding. Proposals should be tied to a specific project, such as attending an artist residency or creating a public work of art. If the applicant is already partnered with a fiscal sponsor—e.g., a nonprofit agency—please make note of that in your proposal. Applications are due **September 1, 2019**.

DIY PRODUCERS

New in 2019, the DIY Fund is a subset of *Get Artistic* grant funding set at \$2,000. Geared toward emerging artists and arts producers in the Athens area, the DIY Fund is available to arts producers, curators, and collectives to fund specific projects, events, or programs **that are not affiliated with an institution**. If the DIY Fund applicant is already partnered with a fiscal sponsor—e.g., a nonprofit agency—please make note of that in the proposal. Applicants must be available to present—or have someone present on their behalf—at Creature Comforts' downtown Athens taproom for a public, science fair-style showcase of the DIY Fund applicant projects on **Sunday, August 18, 2019**. Applications for DIY funds are due **Sunday, July 14, 2019**.
